

## **Fall 2019 Course Descriptions**

**Title:** 501

**Description:** This course will examine the development of literature about King Arthur and his Round Table knights during the Middle Ages. We will look at texts written in English, French, Latin, and Welsh. We will read Middle English texts in the original language and other texts in translation. Readings will include some of the great works by authors such as Geoffrey of Monmouth, Wace, Layamon, Marie de France, Chrétien de Troyes, the Gawain-poet, and Sir Thomas Malory.

**Proposed Readings:** History of the Kings of Britain, The Mabinogion, Yvain, The Knight of the Cart, Lais of Marie de France, Sir Gawain and the Green Knight, Le Morte Darthur
